

Questions Regarding Weddings at Castle Mountain Resort

Can I have my ceremony inside if the weather is uncooperative?

Yes, if the weather is uncooperative you are able to do your ceremony inside.

What is the staff dress code?

Staff will be wearing a white shirt, black pants and black shoes.

Do you provide table service?

Head table yes, everyone else will buffet style.

Can I have my left over's at midnight or take them home with me?

Due to food safe regulations we are not allowed to re-serve food in any way. We are unable to use leftovers in any way.

Can I bring my own caterer?

No, Castle Mountain respectfully declines outside vendors, however wedding cakes are allowed.

Are there special prices for children?

Children eat for ½ price under the age of 12.

Do we have air conditioning?

No, however we do have large ceiling fans to circulate air.

Is there a bride's room?

No, unfortunately don't have a separate room for the bride and groom, however; Castle Central Reservations can assist with this.

Do you provide taste testing?

No, Castle Mountain is a seasonal establishment so we do not have food available for taste testing.

Can I play my iPod or music during dinner?

Yes, both of our sound systems are compatible with an iPod or MP3 player.

Can we have our gift opening the following day or a rehearsal dinner the night before?

Yes for a fee, we can provide catering if required.



Can I give liquor/wine as a wedding favor?

No outside liquor is allowed in CMR facilities due to liquor license restrictions.

Who sets up the ceremony site?

Castle Mountain can set up your ceremony site for a small fee.

Who is responsible for setting up and tearing down the decor, and when will it be completed?

Castle Mountain will set up & tear down tables and place settings, decorating and décor are the responsibility of the wedding couple. Set up can be completed 12pm-4pm on the day before the event; tear down must be completed the night of your event.

Do you allow "Toonie" bars?

Due to Alberta Liquor laws we are unable to provide this service

Should guests bring anything special for the mountain?

Yes, we would recommend that your guest bring flashlights for late at night. We would also recommend warm coats for the evening as it does cool down quite a bit on the mountain.
