We will be experiencing calm conditions and at times light winds at upper elevations, keeping things cool and dry with gobs of sunshine. We have had a lot of new snow snow for the last two weeks but yesterday the sun was shining and the winds were calm & it looks like this might continue for a couple of days just in time for the weekend.
